A Word from Matt

September marks the beginning of the church year. While we don't throw a party, it is a significant event in the life of our church each year. The start of a new church year affords you a valuable opportunity to get involved in new areas in the life of the church. It also gives us time to reflect on all that God has done and seek God's guidance for the future.

There is much to be thankful for in our life as a church. Each week God is honored in our worship services. God is bringing new faces to our church family. For 2025 our worship attendance on Sunday morning is averaging 165. All of this is reason to give thanks to God. However, while God is blessing, there are always places where improvements can be made. While our Sunday worship attendance is averaging 165, our Sunday School attendance is averaging around 70 each week. While this is not a small number, it is an area where we need to seek improvement. So, as we begin a new church year, let me encourage you to be a part of a Sunday School Bible Study class. There are many reasons for being a part of a Sunday School class but let me point out just three big reasons.

1) Discipleship

Sunday school is a wonderful time to study God's word together. The lessons and discussions in the various classes are designed to help you grow in your faith and to help you become more like Jesus. Jesus called disciples and he calls us to make disciples. While we can study the Bible alone, we grow in exponential ways when we study the Bible with other folks together and Sunday School provides a powerful means of group discipleship.

Sunday School classes are the best way to get to know other people in the church. For half an hour or more on Sunday you get to be with people in a concentrated way. You can share prayer concerns and the goings on of life. Most Sundays you will hear laughter coming from our Sunday School rooms and there have been times when tears have been shed by groups together. This fellowship is something that you cannot put a price tag on and something that I personally find invaluable.

3) Outreach

Believe it or not, Sunday School was developed as a means of growing the church. Sunday School is the best means I have ever found for bringing and incorporating new people into the life of the church. If you have a friend who needs to see Christians in action or needs to hear the good news of the Gospel, Sunday School provides a safe and small environment where they can get to know others and be a part of a group.

There are other benefits of Sunday School but let me encourage you, if you are not part of a class, to come and be a part of one. We meet every Sunday Morning at 9:30. If you don't know what class to go to, try each of them out and I can assure you; you will find a class that is where you need to be. I hope to see you on Sunday!


