

A Word from Matt,

As we approach Spring and the change of the seasons is upon us, many of us are looking forward to more daylight, getting outside, and warmer weather. I want you to know that I am personally excited for what God is going to do during the spring season and beyond. I have mentioned several times in recent sermons how important the “one another” passages are in the New Testament as it relates to our life as a church. There are around 50 “one another’s” in the Bible. Some of them like love one another appear over a dozen times, but they are all there to remind us that God desires that we live in community with one another shaped by the Gospel. I want to make this newsletter article simple and encourage you to read over just a few of the “one another” passages below and ask yourself, where do you need to seek God’s help in being a better “one another” Christian.

- **John 13:34 (ESV) — 34** A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.
- **Romans 12:10 (ESV) — 10** Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.
- **Romans 12:16 (ESV) — 16** Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.
- **Romans 14:19 (ESV) — 19** So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding.
- **Romans 15:5 (ESV) — 5** May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus,
- **Romans 15:7 (ESV) — 7** Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.
- **1 Corinthians 12:25 (ESV) — 25** that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.
- **Colossians 3:13 (ESV) — 13** bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.
- **Ephesians 4:32 (ESV) — 32** Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.
- **1 Peter 5:5 (ESV) — 5** Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”
- **Philippians 2:4 (ESV) — 4** Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.
- **1 Thessalonians 5:11 (ESV) — 11** Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.
- **Hebrews 10:24 (ESV) — 24** And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,
- **James 5:16 (ESV) — 16** Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.
